The Sentence

A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

A sentence always begins with a capital letter.

A sentence is divided into two parts:

1. The **Subject** is a person or thing that is doing the action.
2. What is being said about the subject - it is called the **predicate**.

It contains the **verb** and tells us what the subject **does**.

eg:- Tommy and Tammy played all day.

Here the subject is **Tommy and Tammy** and what is being said about Tommy and Tammy is that they **played all day**.



Both, **Tommy and Tammy** and **played all day** have to be put together to form a sentence.
