

A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

A sentence always begins with a capital letter.

A sentence is divided into two parts:

- 1. The **Subject** is a person or thing that is doing the action.
- What is being said about the subject it is called the predicate.
  It contains the verb and tells us what the subject does.

eg:- Tommy and Tammy played all day.

Here the subject is **Tommy and Tammy** and what is being said about Tommy and Tammy is that they **played all day**.

Both, **Tommy and Tammy** and **played all day** have to be put together to form a sentence.
